Perfect! We need you. The McLeod Lake Indian Band is looking to hire a Tse'Khene Elder who is willing to share their knowledge of the Tse'Khene Language. The goal is to archive the language and make it available for generations to come. We currently have 1500 audio recordings of Tse'Khene words, as well as full phrases and sentences. We are looking to record about 1000 more words, about 50 more phrases, as well as need current audio recordings confirmed. During the process, you will be asked to speak the language while being recorded for digital preservation. You'll have the opportunity to help preserve a vital piece of our Tse'Khene Heritage and Culture. We would like to work with the Elder for 3 consecutive days as a start.

The start date is as soon as possible.

Responsibilities

- Listen to Tse'Khene language and translate or confirm
- Speak Tse'Khene while being recorded
- Teach and record any missing Tse'Khene language

- An Elder of the McLeod Lake Indian Band
- Fluent in Tse'Khene
- Have a strong, clear voice
