Albert currently sits on the Elder's Committee and is assisting the Administration with its efforts to revitalize the Tse'khene language. In 2018, Albert attended the UBCIC Conference in Kamloops as a proxy for Chief Chingee, as well as the Union of British Columbia Indian Chiefs in Vancouver in October. He also participated in the Elder's trip to Duncan earlier this year as well.

Albert's commitments focus in Elder health, wellbeing and prosperity. His goal is to work with the Elder Coordinator to ensure there is sufficient housing both on reserve as well as off reserve. His focus is also in language revitalization for the Nation, as he is one of the few Members left who is a fluent speaker. In 2019, he will be involved with the coordination and implementation of various educational forums put forward by the Administration to assist in teaching the Tse'khene language to the Membership.

In 2019, Albert's goal is to address drug and alcohol usage on reserve and assist the Administration in promoting a healthy lifestyle to the Membership.
