Supplemental Kennedy Siding Caribou Feeding Program

McLeod Lake Indian Band (MLIB) has been working in partnership for over the last three years with Tithonus Wildlife Research and the BC Conservation Foundation to provide a supplemental feeding program to the Kennedy Siding Caribou. We would like to continue this important research. To provide these services, we are seeking a contractor who is hard working, loves the land and its animals, committed to this important project and will carry out the tasks in a timely and efficient manner.

Contractor Responsibilities:

Accomplishes objectives by managing and planning their tasks accordingly. The contractor will report directly to the Land Management Officer but will also take direction from Doug Heard, Tithonus Wildlife Research.

Contractor Duties:

The contractor will provide the British Columbia Conservation Foundation with the following services from November, 2019 to January, 2020:

- Provided supplemental food pellets September through mid-January to the Kennedy Siding Caribou Herd at designated feeding stations;
- Monitor and replenish food as required and no more than every other day during the feeding period, to a maximum of 55 days during the Term, and
- Provide reports (bi-weekly) showing dates of replenishment and amount of feed provided at stations.

Contractor Skills, Qualifications and Requirements:

The contractor will have wide knowledge including:

- Values, culture and aspirations of McLeod Lake Indian Band; land governance; and environmental standards and processes, both provincial and federal.

The contractor will meet the following requirements:

- Have a valid British Columbia Drivers' Licence;
- Must maintain and pay for liability insurance on all vehicles owned, operated or licensed;
- Be knowledgeable of the Kennedy Siding area;
- Have experience related to performing such services or a good work history performing contracts;
- The position will require frequent travel between McLeod Lake and Kennedy Siding. The successful candidate will be expected to drive and work in winter conditions;
- The position will take direction from the Land Management department and will report to the Land Management Officer for all activities; and
- The qualified candidate may be required to undergo pre-employment drug and alcohol screening, as well as RCMP criminal records check.
