I am in contact with a group that is doing a study of obstacles that impede fish spawning and they would eventually like to use this information to fix these obstructions so that fish can get upstream of the area to spawn again.

Any information you can send would be great. If you are there in person, you can mark it on google map, take pictures of the culvert in question and of the upstream habitat and the downstream habitat.

If you just have the road name and the kilometers (ie. Carp Lake Road, 2.7km), that would be great also. Don't forget the pictures.

If you have gps coordinates, that would be great as well. Don't forget to send pictures.

Elders, if you know of any part of any creek or stream that used to be loaded with fish and that area was cut off by a culvert of any other obstruction, we want your knowledge so that we can get the fish back into that area.
