- Preference may be given to a candidate who identifies as Indigenous (First Nations, Metis, Inuit).
- Excellent interpersonal skills with the ability to work with people at all levels both internally and externally, including excellent written and verbal skills.
- Must be adept at communicating complex, challenging concepts in a way that other partners are able to understand and operationalize.
- Ability to resolve complex problems and negotiate agreements and resolutions to challenging situations, work collaboratively as part of a cross functional team or independently.
