- Generate production forecasts to support the base business, growth projects, acquisitions/divestures and energy transition projects.
- Support carbon intensity calculations and emission reduction projects.
- Provide training to NorthRiver Midstream team members on evaluation software and data services.
- Provide input and support on project development and commercial operations leveraging experience in the NEBC/Montney and specifically knowledge of NEBC/Montney producers, infrastructure, and commercial arrangements.
- Support fundamental analysis and industry research/reconnaissance including preparing internal/external presentations.
- Assist Commercial and New Ventures teams by organizing/overseeing due diligence processes required as part acquisition and project development initiatives.
- Provide support on developing integrated energy infrastructure proposal and negotiating commercial terms including papering LOIs, MOUs and letter agreements.

- Assist and support with submissions of applications for government funding.
