The objective for this role is to support the operations in achieving targets by completing survey activities including the layout and pickup of drilling, blasting and digging areas.

- Conduct wall monitoring.
- Provide reports to supervisors regarding feedback on loading and dumping areas.
- Record and store data.
- Update drawings using AutoCAD and MineSight.
- Assist with mine planning projects.
- Other duties as assigned by the department head.
