Absence, Late arrival / pickup

Please notify Daycare staff if your Child will be Absent, or late. This allows for faster planning of fieldtrips, outings, and meal preparations.

If your child will be picked up early/late please also advise staff of this change.

Please note**

If recurrences of late pick-ups happen without a phone call to the daycare, you will be charged \$10.00.

Termination, Pick up, Gradual Entry

The Daycare requires 1 month notice if you decide to withdraw them from the program.

Only Authorized people on the Child's registration form will be allowed to pick up, if this person is unrecognized by our staff, they will require identification.

Gradual Entry

We request that parents stay a minimum of 2 hours in the center with their child before they are left alone. This helps the child to become familiar with the program and trust that it is a safe place to be.

*Please note anyone under the influence of alcohol is not allowed to pick up, daycare will call the next emergency contacts provided by the primary caregiver.

Daycare Sickness Policy

If this child is contagious, potentially contagious, or unable to take part in a regular daily program, it is required that parents seek alternate care. The removal of this child will protect the health of other children and staff in the daycare. If a child is home sick for a period exceeding 3 days, a doctor's note may be needed upon return.

Signs to Keep Them Home

If the child is experiences:

Pain or Acute Cold:

with complaints of unexplained or undiagnosed pain, runny nose, coughing, sore throat, or very low energy

Breathing difficulties with fever (100F/38.3C):

Wheezing or coughing May be an indicator of illness and the child may need to see a physician.

Infected Skin or Eyes, acute sore throat, headache or stiff neck, Diarrhea

Unexplained rash(pinkeye, impetigo), difficulty swallowing, cant move properly, headache, loose stool accompanied by nausea, and/or vomiting. These indicate a bacterial infection which is easily spread to others.

Communicable Disease

I.e. Chickenpox, impetigo, roseola, must have a doctor's note before return to the daycare

Please Bring from Home

Please bring an extra change of clothes that can be left at the daycare that includes the following:

- T-shirt
- Underwear (or diapers/pullups, creams, wipes)
- Pants
- Socks
- One pair of indoor shoes (must be able to wear these outside for fire drills)

Please provide your child with appropriate outdoor clothing:

Summer:

- Shorts
- T-shirt
- Light sweater
- Brimmed hat

Fall/Spring:

- Rain coat with hood
- Puddle pants or extra pants
- Rain boots

Winter:

- Warm Coat
- Snow pants
- Boots
- Toque
- Mittens
