McLeod Lake Indian Band has confirmed a Covid-19 outbreak in our community as of February 2nd, 2021. Chief and Council and the Administration and Emergency Management will be working with Northern Health and the First Nations Health Authority to ensure that contact tracing protocols are enacted and that our Band members get the support that they need during this difficult time. As we work on containing the outbreak, the following information is important for all Band Members to read:

Band Hall and TFF Closure

The Band Office and TFF will be closed for the remainder of the week and until further notice. Adele Chingee will be the only staff member permitted in the community until further notice.

Symptoms

Contact Tracing

Please take this time to do some contact tracing and write down the people you have been in contact with over the last week along with contact numbers in case we need to perform contact tracing.

Non-essential Travel Restrictions

Please do not leave the community if it's not an emergency. We will be providing essential services for food and medication.

Self-Isolate

We ask that everyone in the community self-isolate in their homes and not visit others in the community until the outbreak is declared over. Please help us stop the spread of the virus.
