As of January 2020 a new law will come into place that acknowledges First Nations rights to make their own decisions regarding child welfare and safety.

In order to keep our young people close to the community when their families are in need of extra support we need to have a strong network of resources available so that children from McLeod Lake do not end up in MCFD care or with unknown foster carers in other places.

We are looking to put a framework into place that identifies potential safe placements, and the training, supports and resources needed to support those able to offer temporary care for our children and youth.
