This 12-month paid internship program provides a high level of professional development and training that will prepare recent graduates for advancement opportunities and a fulfilling career in government administrations, business development, and/or economic development. A total of 15\* internships are available in 2020 and are set to commence in May.

If you are seeking a challenge and want to apply your education and job-ready skills, consider this extraordinary opportunity to gain experience working in Northern B.C., participate in rural government administration and create a meaningful and rewarding career path.

#### **Intern requirements**

- Completed a bachelor's degree within the previous two years
- Students graduating in May 2020 are eligible
- Undergraduate students can use the internship to complete their co-op terms, as long as they have completed all their other program requirements
- Graduate students are eligible if they are currently enrolled or recently completed their Master's program
- Diploma and certificate students are eligible if they have completed a two-year diploma or public administration certificate/First Nations public administration certificate by the beginning of their internship. *First Nations government internships give priority to qualified Indigenous graduates*
- Willing to relocate to host communities
- Valid B.C. driver's license
- Legally entitled to work in Canada for the duration of the 12-month internship
- Satisfactory criminal reference check
