First Peoples Hospitality Program

Objective

The objective of the First Peoples Hospitality Program is to bring new hospitality opportunities and jobs to Indigenous peoples by providing skills training specific to this industry.

Program Content

During the 18-weeks of in-class training the participants receive instruction based on the S.T.A.R.T or Skills Tasks and Results Training curriculum approved by the American Hotel & Lodging Educational Institute. Additional components include a week of Cultural Awareness & Relativity, Employability Skills & Strategies and Microsoft Applications Training.

This is followed by 6 weeks of on-the-job training to apply the skills learned and gain experience in the Hospitality Industry.

Certificates

During the 18-week in-class training the participants receive the following certificates:

1) SuperHost 2) Foodsafe 3) First Aid – Level 1 4) WHMIS 5) MS Word 2013

Outcome

Ideally, upon completion of the work placement, the workplace host will hire the participant.
