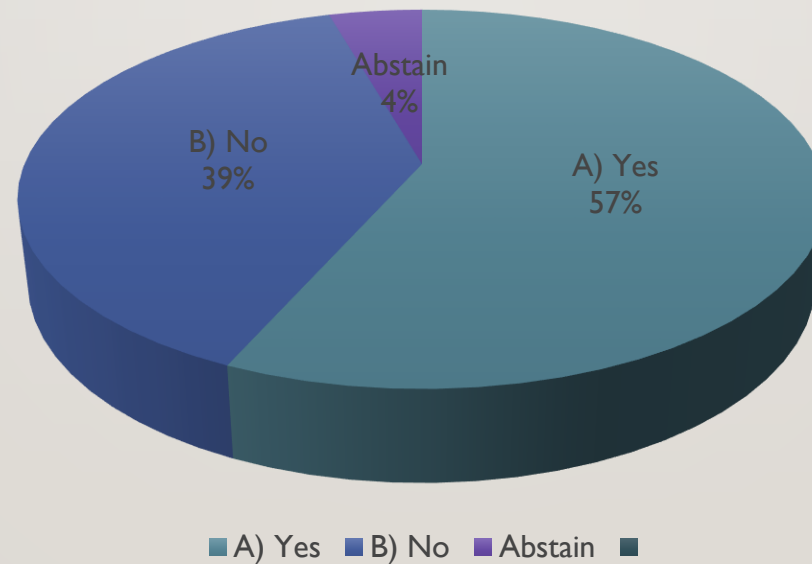

QUARTERLY FEEDBACK

- Questionnaires were handed out to Members at the Prince George, Calgary and Vancouver Christmas Quarterly Meetings
- There was excellent participation overall. Exactly 100 surveys were completed (24 Online, 66 from the Meetings)
- One member expressed concern at the Vancouver Christmas Meeting regarding: How are we ensuring Members are not filling out more than one questionnaire? How are we regulating that non-Members are not filling out this questionnaire? How will we regulate the online survey for Members who could not attend the meetings? How do we prevent anyone from filling out more than once/non-members participating?
- We did our best in regulating who received the surveys at the Quarterly Meetings and Survey Monkey only allows one survey to be filled out per IP address.

Would you support the change of the name from Membership Code to *Membership Law*?



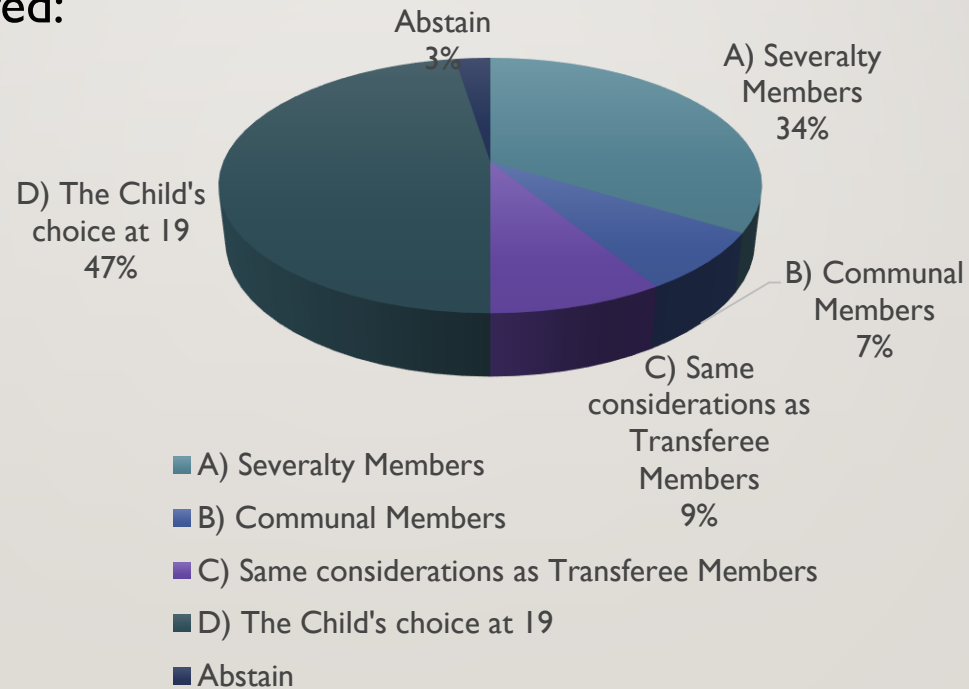
QUESTIONNAIRE RESULTS

- 2) Asks if they still mean the same thing – we need to clarify this for Members *

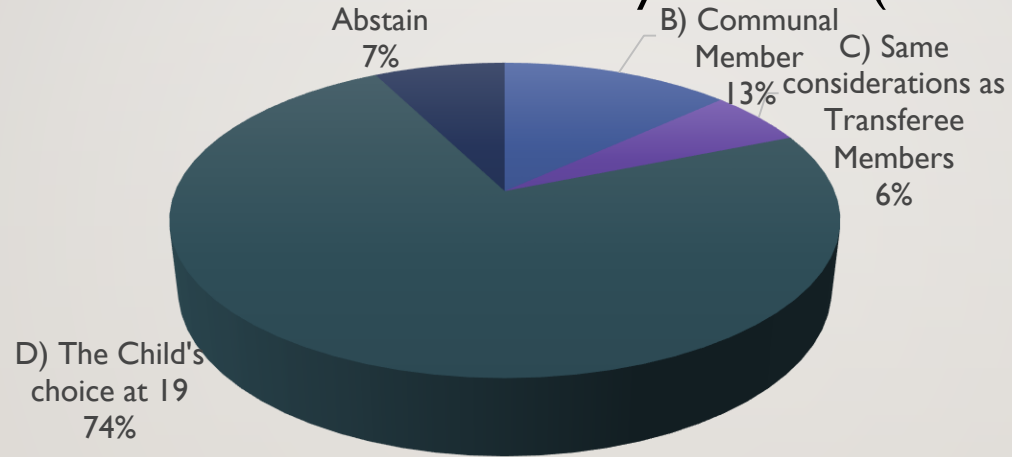

“Kids are people” (Politely)

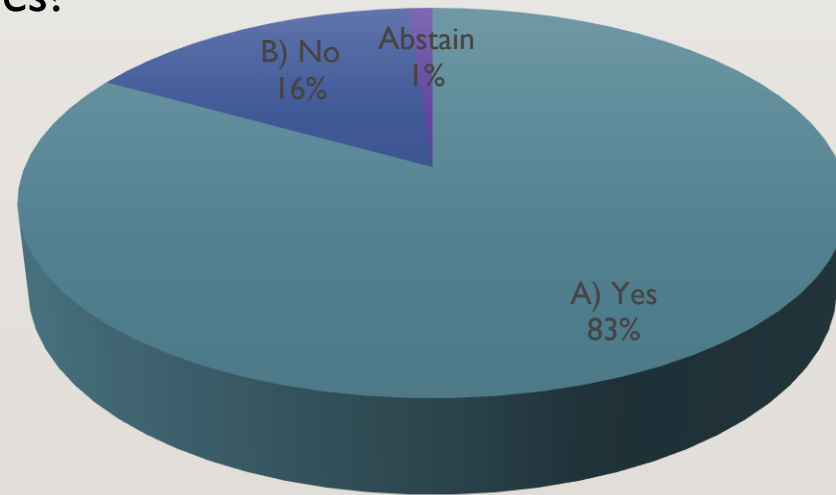
“Communal Member should be stated as ‘regular band member’ so we know what you are talking about – explain questions thoroughly”

Should a Membership Committee be formed to help apply the Membership Code/Law in line with its policies?



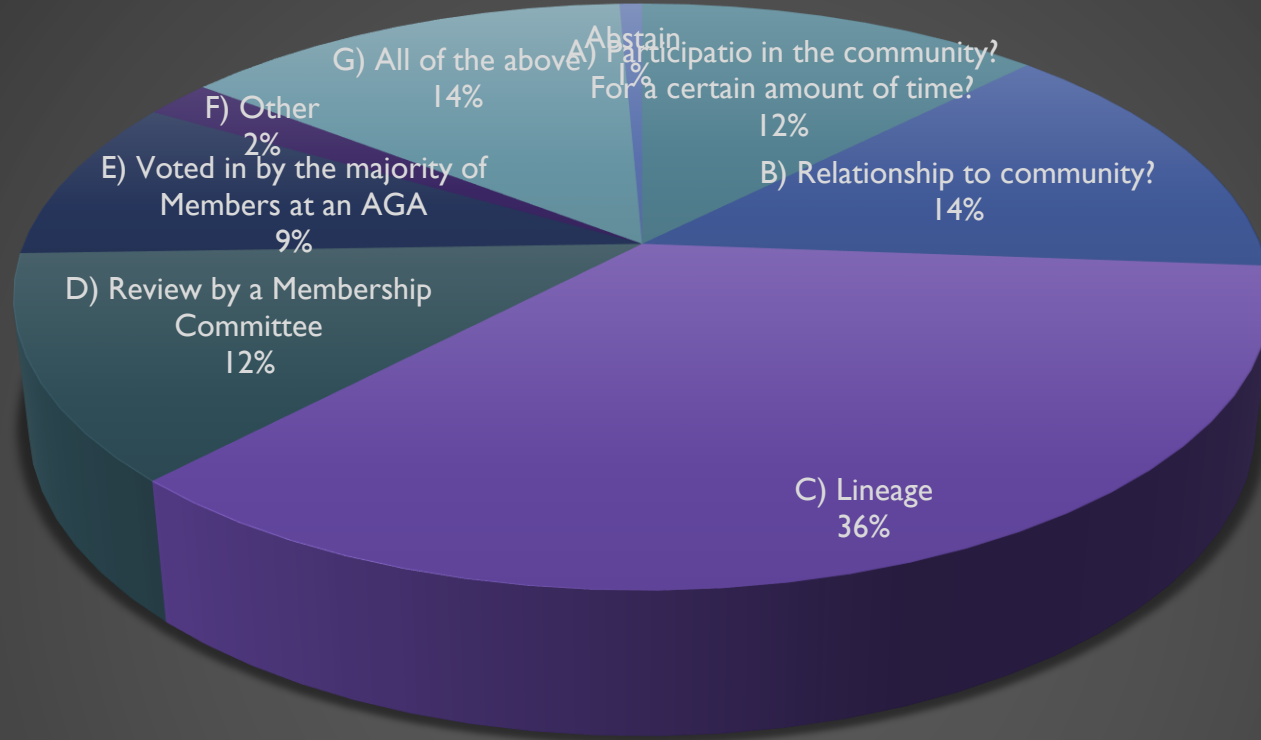

“Quantum blood”

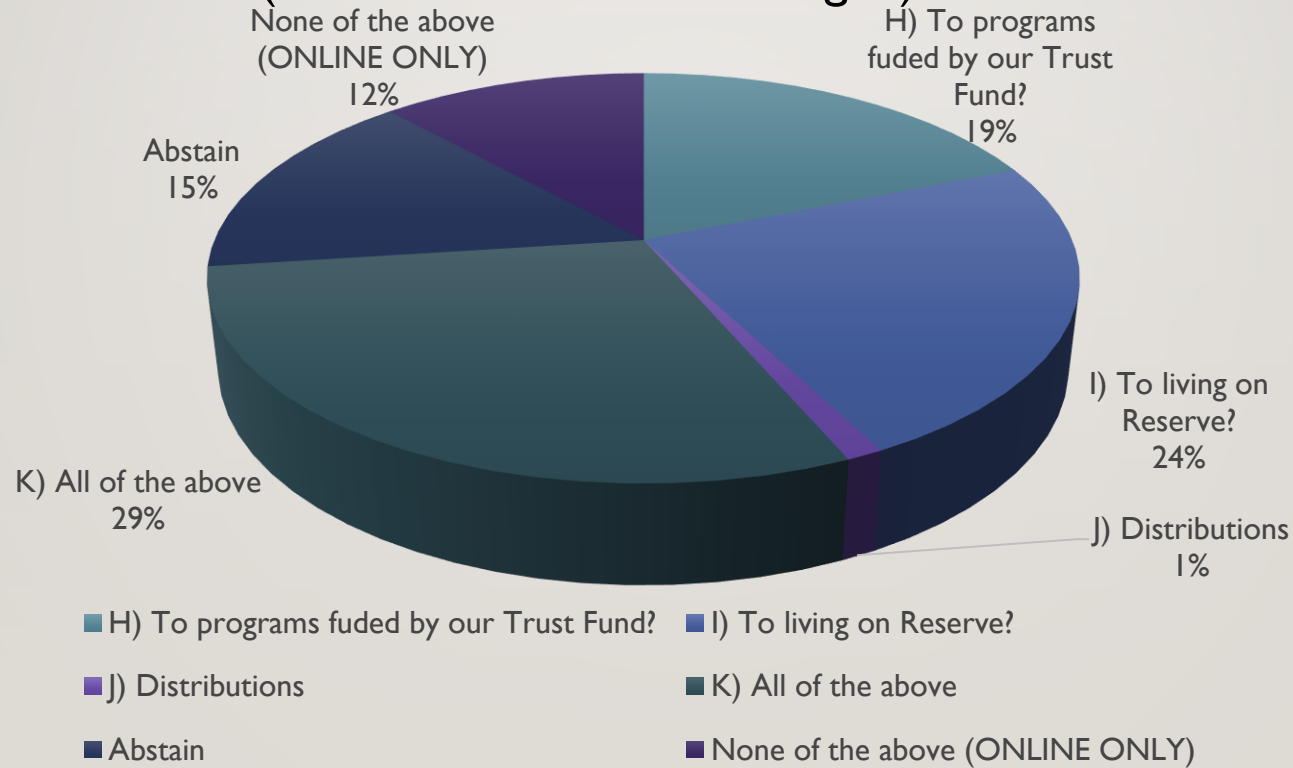
“I believe that people who do not share our bloodline should not have entitlements”

“Need to be part of the community for an extended period of time and a proven active community member. But a certain waitlist period should apply”

“I was told that once I became a member my children would follow suit. My children should be accepted under the old/new membership code and fall into this category hands down”

- 6) Should Transferees (new Members transferring in) have entitlements?



QUESTIONNAIRE RESULTS

- Additional comments to Question 6

“Only INAC funding”

”None of the above” x 8 people

“If Transferees should be communal, so should others”

”Not for the first 4-5 years”

“Prove themselves”

“Quantum blood”

“Not for some time”

“If Transferees want entitlements, it should come out of their parent’s entitlements as per the Treaty 8 negotiations”

*Note: There is a possibility that this was not worded the most appropriately. Possibly due to the amount of abstentions and statements, there should have been an option for “None of the above”

SUMMARY

- The name 'Membership Law/Code' is relatively 50/50. If this is a make or break for Membership to participate, it should likely stay as is because the name does not change the effectiveness or purpose of the document.
- Overwhelming support for Children of Severalty Parents (one OR both) to be Child's choice at 19. More clarification needed to define Communal Members and any other tier of Membership.
- A Membership Committee shall be formed (and further clarified/outlines what it's purpose is for Membership)
- Lineage is extremely important to Membership, overall
- Question 6 is unclear. More clarification is likely needed
