The students will work in various capacities to enhance their employability skills in a safe environment.

### CRITERIA:

- Age 15 years and older
- Must have a valid SIN prior to first day of work
- Must be in good standing with school
- Must be returning back to school
- Must live locally in order to be considered (on-reserve, McLeod Lake community, Mackenzie and/or Prince George)
