The candidates for election were offered inclusion in the Candidate Newsletter, which is a service provided by McLeod Lake Indian Band.

As in previous elections, the candidates for Chief were each allowed two pages, and candidates for all other elected positions were allowed one page each. The pages can be in any format, colour or black and white, typed or handwritten, large or small font. MLIB has not changed any of the text submitted by candidates, but has ensured that the name of each candidate is indicated. Candidates will be listed in alphabetical order by last name.

The deadline for candidates' submissions for the print edition and the first digital post on the MLIB website and Facebook page was May 5, 2023. Late submissions, including revised pages, will be accepted but any such late submissions will only be posted on the MLIB website and Facebook sites as an addendum.

Because of cost, printed editions will be available only in our offices in McLeod Lake and Prince George.

The pages are published by McLeod Lake Indian Band without editing and do not necessarily represent the views of the Administration of McLeod Lake Indian Band. The Candidates are responsible for their own comments – McLeod Lake Indian Band assumes no liability.
