

QCM Core Cutter Position Summer 2025

Centerra Gold Inc (CGI) intends to conduct 7,000 m of diamond drilling at the QCM project, located between Germansen Landing and Mansen Creek, during the summer of 2025. To facilitate this CGI requires core cutters. These positions will be hired through a subcontractor, Exploration Staffing Solutions (ESS).

Core Cutter Job Description:

The primary duties of this position will be:

- Cutting diamond drilled core using a rock saw
- Bagging and tagging the cut samples, and organizational management of the cut samples
- General housekeeping and organization of work spaces
- Other duties may include, but are not limited to: moving core boxes, troubleshooting sample issues, preparing sample bags for cutters, building core storage racks, moving core and core boxes, general lifting and moving
- Transportation to the site is by fixed wing flight from Prince George and is provided by employer.

Qualifications:

- Experience using a rock saw and cutting diamond drilled core is recommended but not required
- Experience sampling cut diamond drilled core: bagging, tagging, and organizing cut samples is recommended but not required
- Team player: must work well with in diverse groups of people for extended periods of time
- Able to work independently when required
- Have a positive and pro-active attitude towards environmental responsibility, health and safety, and respectful workplace practices.
- Be detail oriented and strive for accuracy and consistency
- Physically capable of lifting up to 50-80 lbs and being active for a 12 hour shift
- Comfortable and able to work and live in remote camp settings
