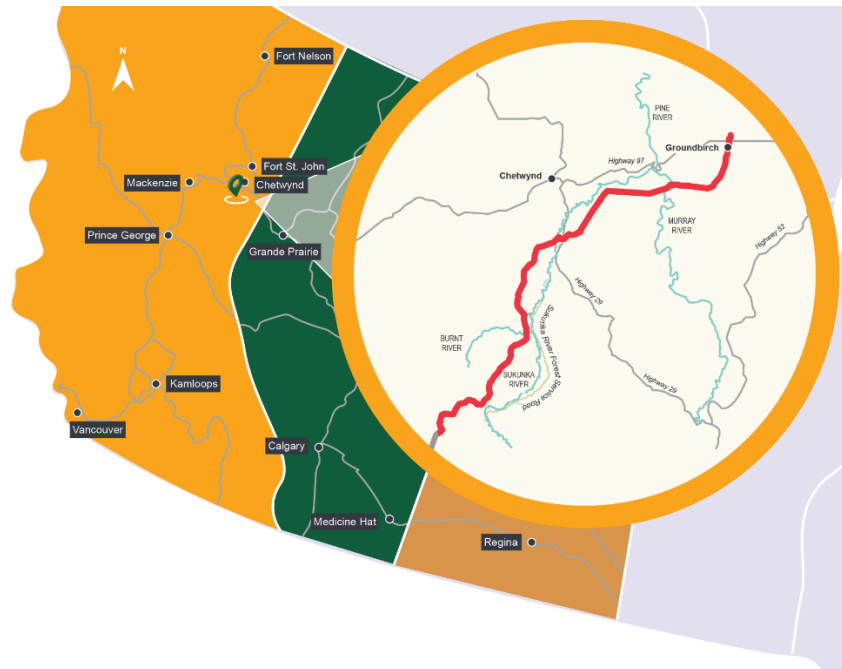


COASTAL GAS LINK PROJECT – SECTIONS 1 & 2

SMJV is constructing 140 kms of 48-inch diameter pipe for the Coastal Gas Link Project. We are currently preparing for our final mechanical installation season and will continue with the final clean-up phase. Workforce will briefly peak at approximately 450 personnel in mid-July. All crews will begin to decrease in late July with the tentative completion in late August of 2023.
