As a Youth Mentor, you will play a role in designing, developing, and implementing programs that inspire, empower, and meet the needs of our youth. Working closely with the community of Mackenzie and on reserve, you'll collaborate with individuals and groups to identify the interests and needs of children and youth. Using your creativity and leadership skills, you'll craft programs and strategies that align with the mission, mandate, and goals of McLeod Lake Indian Band.

Key Responsibilities:

- Supervise and support youth during organized recreational, social, and educational events.
- Motivate and engage youth to actively join in activities and build positive experiences.
- Act as a supportive role model, fostering personal growth and cultural identity.
- Promote a safe and inclusive environment during all activities.
- Assist in the proper use and care of recreation equipment.
- Collaborate with the Youth Coordinator as needed to ensure smooth activity execution.
- Mentor and coach youth to promote confidence, wellness, and social inclusion. Supports, plans and initiates education events.
- Presents a professional, positive, and helpful attitude.
- Promotes a safe workplace; ensures that all established safety, sanitation and hygiene procedures are followed.
